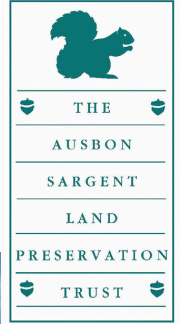


THE SHERMAN FIELD PROJECT

Why is this Project So Important?

This property is well-known to many from the Bradford area. Local interest for the protection of Sherman Field is high, as its topography, size, and frontage on Pleasant View Road make it prime for development. In an effort to protect the local watershed, rural views, public access, and agricultural values, Ausbon Sargent is raising funds to purchase the property so that it may be protected, forever.

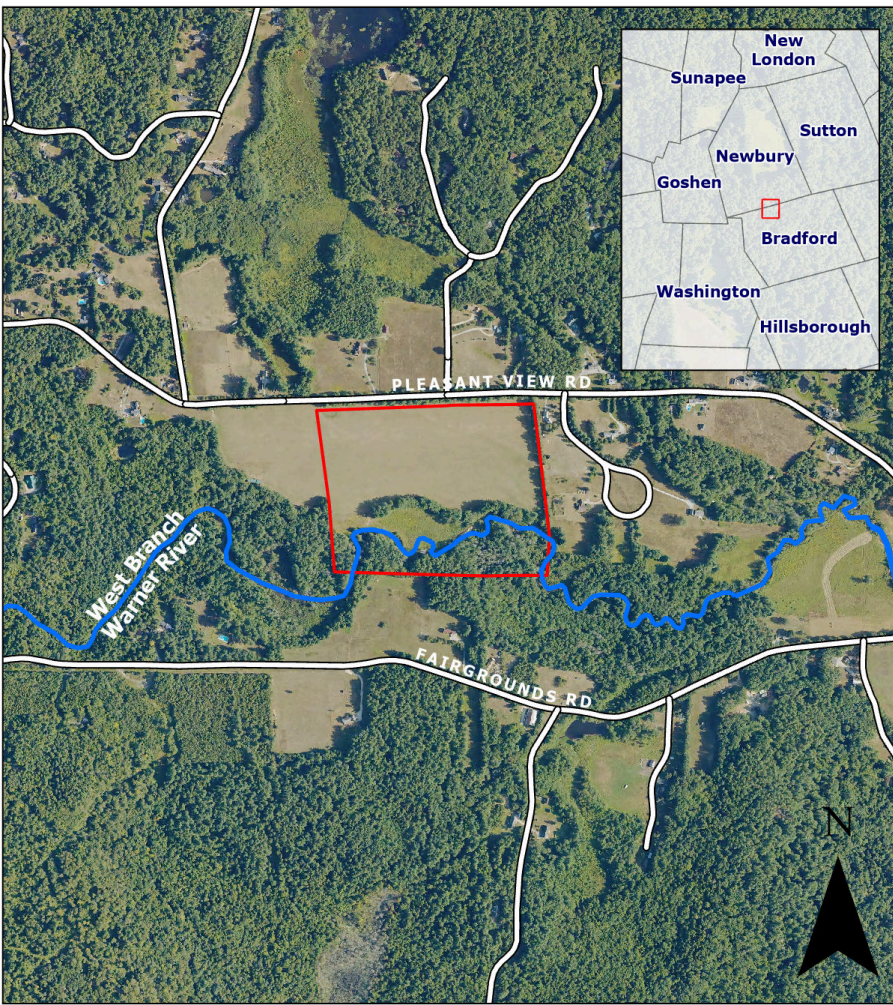
**OUR FUNDRAISING

Additional Information:

- Sherman Field has over 1,600 feet of frontage on both sides of the West Branch of the Warner River.
- The property is highly ranked for wildlife in the 2025 NH Wildlife Action Plan.
- The field will continue to be managed for hay production.
- Partners in this effort include the Town of Bradford, NH Fish & Game, and Trout Unlimited.
- Sherman Field will be open to the public for low-impact recreation.

In addition, a \$200,000 Aquatic Resource Mitigation (ARM) grant has been secured for this project, which will require Ausbon Sargent to restore and improve habitat in the Warner River.
